

# Macromedia (now Adobe)Term Site License Agreement Staff Home Use Agreement



**Murdoch University** ("Licensee") entered into an annual software license agreement with **Macromedia Inc.** who has subsequently been taken over by **Adobe Inc** ("Licensor"). By installing, copying or otherwise using the Software, you agree to be bound by the terms of this Term Site License Agreement ("Agreement"). If you do not agree to the terms of this Agreement, you must not install the software.

Issues relating to the regulation and appropriate use of this software must be managed at a Division or School level. Divisions or Schools may find this form helpful in promoting the responsible use of these products under the 'home use' licence provision. Completed forms should be held by the Division or School, and a copy supplied to IT Service Desk and the employee.

Before installing these products on personally owned or leased workstations, staff should note the following:

1. Software is only to be use for Murdoch University for teaching, administrative and research purposes. Full conditions available at <http://www.its.murdoch.edu.au/license/>
2. Staff using this software on personally owned or leased workstations do so at their own risk. Murdoch University will not accept any responsibility or liability for any consequential damage or lost data resulting from the use of this software.
3. Staff undertake to comply with copyright laws and understand that severe penalties apply to persons who do not comply with software licence provisions.
4. Copies of this software media and/or the ability to use these products must not be passed to persons who are not employed by Murdoch University.
5. Staff electing to use these products on a personally owned or leased workstation must undertake to remove this software from any such workstation on disposal of the equipment, termination of the Term Site License Agreement or termination of employment with Murdoch University, whichever occurs first.
6. The Adobe software may be used both on-campus and off-campus on personally-owned computers as long as the computer's owner is a currently employed Murdoch University staff member. That licence is only valid while the owner of a computer is associated with Murdoch University.
7. Murdoch University and Murdoch University's staff do not own the Software or any copies thereof which are provided under this Agreement.
8. The Software is licensed, proprietary, copyrighted property owned by AdobeINC. Murdoch University as the licensee annually pays a licence fee to enable it to make a limited number of copies of the Software available for use by employees. Any commercial or profit making use of the Software is strictly prohibited; the Software will be used for Murdoch University projects only.
9. Murdoch University staff will not modify, reverse assemble or decompile the Software.
